

**Stopping 1 dump is not enough. We must stop
NC from becoming a dumping ground.
Write your legislators to pass important bills.
Here's how.**

Sims Hugo Neu has announced it will not build a landfill on Mount Misery Road. The site is former unincorporated Brunswick County property that was satellite annexed by the town of Navassa.

We cannot claim victory yet. Sims Hugo Neu still owns the property, now zoned as heavy industrial, and could sell the site for a use as bad as the proposed dump.

How can we make sure this doesn't happen? **By writing our representatives to encourage them to vote for legislation introduced by the bi-partisan team of Bonner Stiller (Brunswick-R), Dewey Hill (Columbus-D) as follows:**

H427, Navassa Zoning Jurisdiction divests planning jurisdiction from Town of Navassa over a parcel of land it annexed for the site of the Sims Hugo Neu auto fluff landfill. This bill gives planning jurisdiction to Brunswick County, which is opposed to the landfill.

H428, Navassa Deannexation repeals the Town of Navassa's annexation of the parcel of land. It places the land use decision in the hands of the county, which is opposed to the landfill.

Solid Waste Management Act of 2007 is legislation being considered to strengthen landfill regulations in North Carolina. This legislation will ensure the State doesn't become the dumping ground for other states' and countries' garbage.

The current landfill moratorium expires August, 2007. Please write or email your legislators, or the entire legislative body, to ask for their support to make these bills laws during the current legislative session. Further, please pass along this information and requests to your friends and relatives throughout the State. It is important that our statewide representatives hear our voices. Sample letters are printed on the back.
